


Welcome to Yeshiva Success Network - Getting Started

The Yeshiva Success Network (YSN) is a quick and easy way to find resources, assistance, and academic support online. Through this portal you can connect with offices on campus, your instructors, and your Academic Advisors.

Getting started is easy. You can find the link on InsideTrack, Yeshiva Success Network. It is also accessible directly [here](#). Use your Single Sign On information when prompted. From there, you can click around the site to see your staff connections, important office resources, and schedule appointments on campus. Step One is to set up your profile.

Setup your Profile

1. Click on the three lines in the top left corner, then click your name in the Top Navigation bar and select the **Edit Profile** tab.

5. Here you can set your desired preferences for any appointments you schedule within the portal. YSN can send you a notification reminder as you wish.
6. Click the **Submit** button to save your changes.
